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## LESSON 14: Be Smart! Get the Message Out!

### OBJECTIVE

- Students will design a way to help get the message out to the community.

### LESSON OVERVIEW

## PROCEDURE

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### Step 14.1: Students Discuss How to Get the Message Out.

- **Tell Students:** We are now going to help get the message out to adults and children in our community.
- **Tell Students:** Now we need to think about the projects that we have completed in our Take the Challenge lessons.
  - In Lesson 6 we made junk art projects.
  - In Lesson 10 we wrote zombie paragraphs.
  - In Lesson 11 we changed song lyrics to teach what we've learned during the Take the Challenge lessons.
  - In Lesson 13 we wrote friendly letters to our parents.

**Ask Students:** Which of these projects would best help get the message out?

### Step14.2: Students Create Display

Discuss how we will get this important message out to our community.
